Her experiences include drafting the winning brief that successfully opposed a petition for writ of certiorari before the United States Supreme Court; leading a bid protest where she obtained emergency restraints and ultimately secured both preliminary and permanent injunctions; and serving as first chair in trial court matters, where she prevailed on evidentiary motions excluding thousands of documents from the opposing party’s case. Amanda has also represented corporations in mechanics’ lien hearings, protecting their rights and defeating counterclaims in full.

In addition to her courtroom practice, Amanda advises companies on risk management in areas that often intersect with commercial litigation, including collective bargaining agreements, freight charge liability, and intellectual property protection. This dual focus on litigation and preventative counsel allows her to resolve immediate disputes while helping businesses anticipate and avoid future challenges.

She actively works with victims of domestic violence, representing survivors in trial proceedings, securing protective orders and negotiating favorable civil agreements.
